The ISDE is a multi-disciplinary organization, which aims to gather together all specialties involved in the clinical management and research of patients with esophageal diseases. Ancona as co-chairs. As the field of esophageal disease continues its rapid evolution, we are confident that the Congress will again be a high caliber meeting with cutting-edge science and new clinical insights.
