

## 2021 Best Junior Faculty/Trainee Manuscript Award

*Diseases of the Esophagus* will be giving an award to the top original research manuscript by a junior faculty or trainee author accepted for publication in the journal.

### Award

- The winner of the award will receive complimentary registration to attend the 2021 ISDE World Congress that will be held virtually from September 27-30, 2021,
- The winner of the award will be recognized in the following ways:
  - September 2021 issue of *Diseases of the Esophagus*,
  - At the DOTE Festival during the 2021 Virtual World Congress,
  - On ISDE Social Media (Twitter, Facebook) in September 2021.
- Complimentary ISDE membership of 1 year for regular member (expires December 31, 2022) or 2 years for trainee member (expires December 31, 2023),
- Certificate.

### Judging Criteria

The winner of the award will be determined by the co-Editors in Chief of *Diseases of the Esophagus*.

Criteria that will be considered will include:

- Contribution of the junior faculty or trainee author,
- Scientific methodology of the manuscript,
- Clinical impact of the manuscript,
- Citations accumulated within the first 6 months of publication,
- Media impact within the first 6 months of publication.

### Qualifications

- The first author of the manuscript must be a trainee physician or a junior faculty physician with less than 5 years from completion of training at the time of submission for publication,
- The manuscript must have been accepted for publication in *Diseases of the Esophagus* between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020.

- Cover letter by applicant outlining their personal contribution to the published manuscript,
- Letter from mentor / senior author stating the level of training or date of completion of training for the applicant at the time of manuscript submission,
- Title of the published manuscript.
