

2021 Best Junior Faculty/Trainee Manuscript Award

Diseases of the Esophagus will be giving an award to the top original research manuscript by a junior faculty or trainee author accepted for publication in the journal.

Award

- The winner of the award will receive complimentary registration to attend the 2022 ISDE World Congress being held from September 26-28, 2022
- The winner of the award will be recognized in the following ways:
 - At the DOTE Festival during the 2022 World Congress
 - On ISDE Social Media (Twitter, Facebook) in September 2022
- Complimentary ISDE membership of 1 year for regular member (expires December 31, 2023) or 2 years for trainee member (expires December 31, 2024)
- Certificate

Judging Criteria

The winner of the award will be determined by the co-Editors in Chief of *Diseases of the Esophagus*. Criteria that will be considered will include:

- Contribution of the junior faculty or trainee author
- Scientific methodology of the manuscript
- Clinical impact of the manuscript
- Citations accumulated within the first 6 months of publication
- Media impact within the first 6 months of publication

Qualifications

- The first author of the manuscript must be a trainee physician or a junior faculty physician with less than 5 years from completion of training at the time of submission for publication
- The manuscript must have been accepted for publication in *Diseases of the Esophagus* between January 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021

How to apply

- Cover letter by applicant outlining their personal contribution to the published manuscript
- Letter from mentor / senior author stating the level of training or date of completion of training for the applicant at the time of manuscript submission
- Title of the published manuscript
